The Calculation of GP (Grade Point) and Cumulative GPA (Grade Point Average)

Enrollment in or after 2015 (H27) *For graduate school: Enrollment in or after 2017 (H29)

GP	Grade	Assigned Meaning
4	S	Has reached and exceeded the performance goals/Outstanding
3	A	Has reached and exceeded the performance goals
2	B	Has reached the performance goals sufficiently
1	C	Has reached the minimum performance goals
Blank	Transferred credit	

<Optional> GP 3.5, 2.5 or 1.5 can be used. They are equivalent to A+, B+ or C+ respectively.

Enrollment in or before 2014 (H26) *For graduate school: Enrollment in or before 2016 (H28)

GP	Grade
3.0 – 5.0	A
2.0 – 2.9	B
1.0 – 1.9	C
Blank	Transferred credit

<Remarks>

Credits earned at other institutions before enrolling in Saitama University will be approved and transferred after careful consideration. In most cases, however, the grades for such credits will not be presented as scores. In addition, some courses at Saitama University are not evaluated by scores, such as those that are involved with getting qualifications. Saitama University terms these courses “Transferred Credit” courses, which are left blank in the GP column on the transcript to distinguish them from other courses.

“Transferred Credit” courses do not affect the cumulative GPA.

Formula

(1) How to calculate GP (Grade Point) (Enrollment in or before 2014 / H26)
(For graduate school: Enrollment in or before 2016/H28)

$$GP = \frac{(\text{Score out of 100}) - 50}{10}$$
